

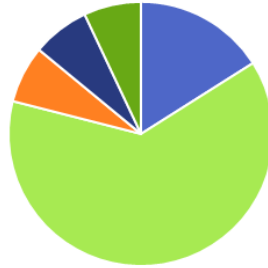

**73%** of recipients qualified for **HIGH Financial Need status**

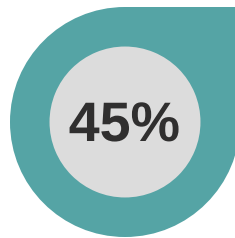


### Race/Ethnicity
